

VILLAGE OF ELLENVILLE
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
APRIL 20, 2011
MINUTES

The regular March meeting of the Village of Ellenville Historic Preservation Commission was called to order at 5:52 p.m. in the 4th floor meeting room of the Government Center by Chair Marion M. Dumond.

Present: Commissioners Draganchuk, Dumond and Zelnik.

Minutes of the March 16, 2011 meeting were approved by Commissioners.

Commissioner Dan Johnson resigned. Dumond forwarded the information to the Village Clerk for filing.

Website Updates – 2011 minutes have been added and are up-to-date on the website. Draganchuk to send membership application to N. Dechon for inclusion on website.

The Commission unanimously agreed to work on local landmark designation for Thornton's Hardware, the Berger and Solomon building and the Slutsky Center during 2011.

Bill Krattinger has confirmed that he will be in attendance at the May 18, 2011 meeting to discuss plans for introducing and informing the community about the historic district. This meeting will start at 5:00 pm. Dumond will invite the Village Manager, Village Clerk, Building Inspector, Jill Fisher and Bill Larson.

Dumond to look into the possibility of selling the village survey. The Town of Rochester does this and sells a copy in color for \$75 and in black and white for \$25.

The Commission discussed the possibility of creating a brochure that will address the rules and responsibilities for an owner of a local landmark. This is something the town and the village can collaborate on in the future.
