Under "Old Business", regarding the Ellenville/Wawarsing Park, Jeff Rubin reported that he has been in touch with Hank AJicandri who indicated that there is not much new at this time, but that a grant proposal is being written. Paul shared that he is concerned about security at the park, and Jeff Rubin stated that Barton and Loguidice has been discussing additional lighting and the police department is monitoring the area in an effort to prevent vandalism.

Congratulations to Jeff Slade on his being reappointed Chairman of the JHPC for 2019.

The Nevele Schoolhouse continues to be a concern because of its deteriorating condition and the vandalism that is quite evident. There was some discussion regarding precautions that may be taken to prevent further damage.

Under "New Business", Jeff Rubin shared that he attended a Preservation Expo in Marbletown on March 30th and heard Ken Follett speak about the Jean Hasbrouck House. Jeff was able to speak to Mr. Follett afterward, and he indicated he is willing to meet with the JHPC. Mr. Follett is a good resource for us who can address questions homeowners may have regarding the historic value of their home.

The next meeting will be held on Monday, May 13, 2019 at 4 P.M., and today's meeting was adjourned at 4:38 P.M.
